Place figures in the text, text wrapping - top and bottom, central alignment. All figures should be numbered. Put the number of the figure under the figure (e.g., Fig. 1.) and the caption, as well as its description (if

necessary), with the central alignment. All tables should be numbered (e.g., Table 1.). Tables should have caption, central alignment. Font size of text in tables - 14 or 12, spacing - 1.

Applications and abstracts should be created as separate files according to the sample: Petrenko_Zayavka (for the application), Petrenko_Tezy (for abstracts) in doc. or docx format.

WARNING! Authors are responsible for the accuracy of the provided information and the uniqueness of the materials submitted for printing. Abstracts should be carefully prepared as required. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject abstracts submitted to the conference in case of non-compliance with the established requirements.

The structure of the abstracts of the report:

• Title of abstracts (bold, size: 14, centered).

Applicants must also provide their level of higher education (first, second and third) and information about the supervisor. (normal font, size: 14). Students must also provide the level of higher education (first, second and third) and information about the supervisor (regular font, size: 14).

• Main text.

• References should be given in alphabetical order or in the order of their appearance in the text according to the APA (American Psychological Association) style (more information http://nbuv.gov.ua/node/929). References in the form of author's name and year of publication should be given in brackets in text, (e.g., Petrenko, 2008).
